Camp Erin Toronto is a free, children's bereavement camp for youth who are grieving the death of a significant person in their lives.



Children and teens ages 6 to 17 participate in an **overnight camp experience** that combines grief education and emotional support with fun, traditional camp activities. Led by bereavement professionals and caring volunteers, campers are provided a safe environment to explore their grief, learn essential coping skills, and make friends with peers who are also grieving.

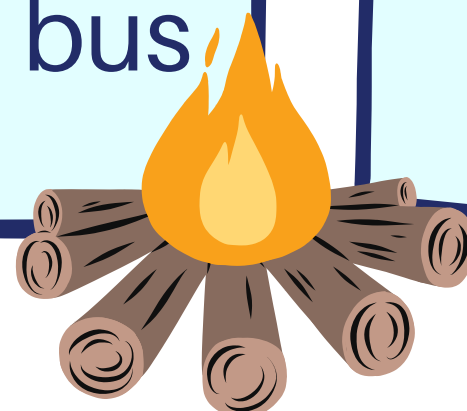
